Structuring a Guided Reading Lesson Made Easy - Mrs ...
This can vary slightly depending on the region in which you teach but the most commonly used method of guided reading assessment used is the alphabetical system developed by Fountas, and Pinnell in the 1990's. The levels range alphabetically from A to Z, with level A representing the lowest level and level Z the highest.
