### Identifying Sounds of Poetry Worksheet for 5th - 8th Grade ...

Rhyme is the repetition of similar sounds. In poetry, the most common kind of rhyme is the end rhyme, which occurs at the end of two or more lines. It is usually identified with lower case letters, and a new letter is used to identify each new end sound. Take a look at the rhyme scheme for the following poem : I saw a fairy in the wood,
