To indicate short quotations (four typed lines or fewer of prose or three lines of verse) in your text, enclose the quotation within double quotation marks. Provide the author and specific page number (in the case of verse, provide line numbers) in the in-text citation, and include a complete reference on the Works Cited page.

### **MLA Formatting Quotations // Purdue Writing Lab**

Provide the title of the article in double quotation marks. Type the title of the article in title case, capitalizing the first word and all nouns, pronouns, adjectives, adverbs, and verbs. If there is a subtitle, place a colon at the end of the title and then type the subtitle in title case.

## **How to Cite Online Articles in MLA: 10 Steps (with Pictures)**

Articles with more than two authors are cited by the first authors last name followed "and others" or "et al.", and then the year. When a book, paper, or article has no identifiable author, cite it as Anon. Year, e.g., (Anon. 1996) (Anon. is the abbreviation for anonymous). See Full Citation.

## **How to Write Guide: How to Cite Other Papers in Your Paper**

APA citation basics When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, like, for example, (Jones, 1998). One complete reference for each source should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.

Cite by listing the article's author, putting the title of the article in quotations marks, and italicizing the periodical title. Follow with the date of publication. Remember to abbreviate the month.

Academic papers in APA citation has general writing guidelines. Papers should be typed, double-spaced on standard-sized paper (8.5" x 11") with 1" margins on all sides. You should use a clear font

that is highly readable. APA recommends using 12 pt. Times New Roman font.

Give the secondary source in the reference list; in text, name the original work and give a citation for the secondary source. For example, if Allport's work is cited in Nicholson and you did not read Allport's work, list the Nicholson reference in the reference list. In the text, use the following citation:
